

## NELLIE GAIL POOL RULES

CURRENT

The rules governing the Nellie Gail Swim Club are to ensure your safety and comfort while using the facility. Please read and abide by the following:

1. Showering is required before entering the pool.
2. Dispose of food and drinks when finished from the designated eating areas.
3. Notify the aquatic staff of any spills or clean ups.
4. Absolutely *NO* running at any time, this includes using the diving platforms.
5. A 72-hour advance notice is required to the aquatic staff of any parties or social gatherings. There may be additional fees involved depending on the size of your party.
6. NO eating or drinking inside the pools or spa.
7. Absolutely *NO* glass containers allowed in the pool area.
8. No gum or sticky candy allowed in the pools, spa or on the pool deck.
9. Return patio furniture back to its original location.
10. Do not obstruct pump room door, eyewash, gates or emergency exits.
11. For safety concerns keep at least a five-foot clearance from the pool edge.
12. Swim lessons of any kind shall not be conducted without first obtaining written authorization from the swim director.
13. An adult must accompany children under the age of 13 at all times.
14. An adult must accompany children 14 and older when the lifeguard is NOT on duty. Check with the aquatic staff for lifeguard schedules.
15. Parents are responsible for their children regardless if a lifeguard is on duty or not.
16. You must be 14 years or older to use the spa all others must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
17. The wader pool is intended for children five years of age and younger, adult supervision is required.
18. Incontinent members must wear a fresh swim diaper & plastic pant at all times. Swim diapers are available through the aquatic office.
19. Obtain permission from the aquatic staff before using Nellie Gail Swim Club owned kickboards, equipment and toys. All pool toys and equipment must be returned to the storage bin.
20. The diving well (deep end) is the only area authorized for general diving purposes.
21. Any type of rough activity is not permitted (i.e., chicken fights, throwing of objects, and careless diving, etc.). *No* playing or hanging on the lane lines.
22. In accordance with the Health Department regulation, pets are not permitted within the pool area.
23. A member must accompany all guests. Guest fees are \$3.00 per person each visit. Members are limited to three guests per visit. Excessive use by a single guest may result in access to the facility denied.
24. Shirt and shoes are required in the clubhouse. No wet suits are allowed in the clubhouse.
25. Proper swimsuits must be worn at all times (i.e., no cut off pants or tennis shorts).
26. Smoking or the use of illegal drugs is prohibited.
27. Stay in designated open swim areas only.
28. The starting blocks are to be used only while being supervised by authorized aquatic staff or licensee.
29. The lifeguards have full authority to prohibit anyone who does not abide by the rules from using the facility.
